## 2025 International Classic Table Tennis Federation World Cup!

*Sanctioned by the ICTTF and supported by the US Classic Association*

**SATURDAY JULY 27<sup>th</sup>, 2024**

**WHAT:** ICTTF US Southern Summer Qualifier for the 2025 World Cup in Mexico City, Mexico

**WHERE:** Impact Table Tennis, 1642 Old Apex Rd., Cary, North Carolina 27513

**WHEN:** Saturday July 27<sup>th</sup>; 9:00 am – 5pm

Background: This Qualifier is a sanctioned tournament by the International Classic Table Tennis Federation (ICTTF) and serves as one of the US Qualification Events for the 2025 ICTTF Classic World Cup. **The winner of the Open Sandpaper event; Open Hardbat event and Open Wood Event will earn a spot to compete at the 2025 ICTTF World Cup.** Additional spots may also be awarded to winners of the remaining events.

**FORMAT:** RR Groups – Top winner in each group advances to a final SE Round

*Junior Events = U18 years of age as of December 31, 2024*

*Senior Events = Veteran's Over 60 years old as of July 27, 2024*

## PRIZES:

1. Medals to All Winners, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place participants for all events.
2. Winners of events will receive a Certificate of Qualification (COQ) from ICTTF for attendance and participation in the 2025 World Cup.
3. Additionally, the USCA may potentially receive a **subsidy** from ICTTF for award by USCA to a player to attend the 2025 World Cup. If this materializes, this will be entirely the decision of ICTTF to award it to USCA, and USCA will award it to a player in the USA as it sees fit.

## RULES AND GUIDELINES:

1. Results of this tournament will be sent to the ICTTF for inclusion in their ratings for wood, sandpaper and hardbat. Potential participation at the World Cup is extended to Winners of each event by receipt of a Certificate Of Qualification.
2. **\*\*Entry in ANY event will also give you 2024 membership in both the USCA AND THE ICTTF ! \*\* WOW!**
3. All matches, in all events, at this qualifier are 3 out of 5 to 11 points. Note that ICTTF scoring system will be different at the World Cup.
4. Any 'All wood' racket is authorized for the bare wood event at this qualifier. Be aware that ICTTF may specify wood types and authorized rackets for mandatory use at the World Cup.
5. Any 'All Wood' racket with a sandpaper surface is authorized for the sandpaper events at this qualifier. Be aware that ICTTF may specify sandpaper racket types and authorized rackets for mandatory use at the World Cup.
6. Any 'All Wood' racket with ox (no sponge) short pips (pimpled rubber) is authorized for the hardbat events at this qualifier. Be aware that ICTTF may specify hardbat racket types and authorized rubber sheets for mandatory use at the World Cup.
7. The Tournament Director (TD) is the 'go to' person for questions or conflict resolution. However, no umpires are provided at this tournament – keep track of things yourself and resolve any issues between you and your opponent in a civil manner. When unsure of score, go back to the point where both players agree upon a score (*if a point or score is in doubt*).
8. Profanity, shouting, physical alterations, or any other disruptions as determined by the TD will result in the participant being disqualified, removed from play, scores not submitted, and, no refunds given. **Excessive 'cho-ing' is greatly frowned upon and can easily result in player disqualification – so be civil, polite, and courteous.**
9. By competing in this tourney, I agree to have my photo taken and included in the ICTTF Newsletter along with a article. Additionally, I agree to have my photo and/or an article posted on facebook.

**FEES:** All players must pay a **\$15/event entry fee.**

No maximum # of events – sign-up for as many as you like – no event conflicts exist.
