- **Venue:** Bellevue College, 3000 Landerholm Cir SE, Bellevue, WA 98007 (Courter Family Athletic Pavilion G)
- **Tournament Equipment:** Joola 3000SC Tables, VM Nets, Joola Prime 3-star ABS white balls 40+. Play is on hardwood floor.

- ****Open Singles Format:**
 - Will consist of four stages. The top twelve seeds will qualify automatically to Stage 3.
 - Stage 1 (Sat 10am) - Seed 13th and below will be drawn into RR groups of four with two players advancing.
 - Stage 2 (Sat 1pm) - Single elimination until four players remain.
 - Stage 3 (Sat 5pm) - The four qualified players will join the twelve seeded players in four RR groups of four players, two players will advance from each group.
 - Stage 4 (Sunday): Single elimination – quarters (11am), semis (2:30pm) and final (4pm).
- **Format for other events:**
 - RR events will have 3-4 players. Groups of 4 will be prioritized based on the number of entries and time. **One** player advances from the group.
 - Depending on the number of entries, the top few seeds on some RR events except open singles may be seeded directly into the SE rounds and not play in the groups.

- **Finals Schedule on Sunday:** We plan to finish most events by 2:00pm so that everyone can enjoy the Open Singles semis, Women's and Open finals. We'll remove most tables, vacate the gym and setup a center court with around 1,500 spectator capacity. All participants will be provided a general admission ticket to the Semi-Finals and Finals of the Open event. Please do not lose this as you will not be permitted in the center court without a ticket. **Tickets will be \$10 each – all non-participants are required to buy a ticket.** Other notable finals: Open doubles 1:00pm, Women's Singles 2:00 pm.
- **Afterparty (Sunday 6-9 PM):** Spin Seattle (1511 6th Ave Seattle, WA 98101 - 15 min drive from Bellevue College) will be hosting it. Entrance to the main facility is free for all ages (food and drinks for sale). We'll also have the VIP Room (21+) reserved for our top players and 50 VIP ticket holders. *VIP tickets are \$50 and include: Court side seats for the Open finals Sunday Afternoon and Food and Drink catering menu at the Afterparty* – don't miss the chance to mingle with the top players! Tickets are first come first served.
- When possible, draws will be made using geographic separation so that players from the same Club / City / State do not play in the same groups/ first round (don't forget to indicate your club on your entry)
- All matches will be the best of five games except for the Open singles Finals and Semis and Women's singles final which will be best of seven.
- The gym will be open for practice 5:30-7pm on Friday, 8 am on Saturday and Sunday. Pre-match warm-ups will be limited to 2 minutes. Players must register with tournament officials at least 30 minutes before their first match and be ready to play each match 10 minutes before the scheduled starting time. Entering two events with the same starting time is not permitted.
- Every event is scheduled to start on time and continue until it's finished (events starting at 2:00 PM or later on Saturday may carry over elimination rounds to Sunday).
- For the tournament to run on time, each event has a maximum player limit. Once the maximum number of **paid** entries per event are reached, new entries will be placed on a waitlist in the order they're received until the entry deadline when the final list will be posted.
- Players must be members of the USATT, CTTA, or other ITTF affiliates with memberships valid through August 31st, 2020.
- All USATT regulations apply. Only ITTF and USATT approved equipment will be used. The USATT Dress Code applies. No white shirts, shorts or skirts allowed.
- Unrated players may enter any singles event. However, they will NOT advance out of a round-robin round in any rating-restricted events except for U1200/Unrated. They can only advance in the 'Open Singles', 'Women Singles', 'Open Doubles', 'Under 18, '40 and Over' events. Unrated players cannot enter doubles rating events.
- Maximum player rating for doubles: U4200 – 2500, U3200- 2100. Prize money is per team.
- For 'Under 18' events the participant must be under 18 years old on the first day of the tournament. For '40 and Over' event the participant must be 40 old on Dec 31st, 2020.
- For event eligibility the ratings as of July 18th, 2020 will be used. For seeding purposes, the most recent available ratings will be used. For Open and Women Singles, any player with an ITTF Aug 2020 list WR of 100 or above will be seeded according to their WR first. Players with no WR or below WR 100 will be seeded according to their USATT rating or estimated rating. Non-U.S. based players that have a USATT rating older than 2 years may be adjusted based on their country's ranking or most recent rating. Unrated players must obtain an estimated rating from a local coach or the tournament committee to be properly seeded.
- No prizes will be awarded for splits, defaults and no-shows. **Default time is the event start time.** Payment for online registration must be received within three days or your entry may be removed to free up a slot for another player.
- **Entry deadline is Friday July 31st, 2020. No entries will be accepted after that or refunds given.** Refunds given for events cancelled by management.
- Tournament management reserves the right to modify, combine, or cancel events, limit total participants or total entries by event. If an event is cancelled the fees for that event will be refunded.
- Trophies, medals, and awards must be picked up at the control desk by players. Players who receive \$600 or more must fill out Form W-9 (Request for Social Security or Employer ID number). All international prize money winners are required to provide a Passport/Visa. We are required by the U.S. Department of Treasury to withhold 30% tax on all prize money recipients from countries that do not have a treaty with the U.S.

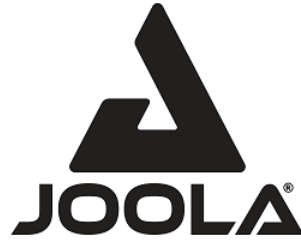
