Eligibility: Open to all USATT, CTTA or any other ITTF affiliate members. Non-members must join USATT to participate any sanctioned events. Membership may be purchased with your entry. You may be asked to show proof of recent membership if your name is not on the current USATT list.

Deadline: All paid entries received by March 6th will be guaranteed participation. Entries received after the deadline may be accepted on a space-available basis. Cancellation will only be refunded if notification is given before March 5th

Check-in: Players should check-in as early as possible and should arrive **NO LATER** than 30 minutes prior to the starting time for their earliest event. (Note: The venue opens at 8:00am).

Format:

- All events (Singles and Doubles) are round robin for the first round. Subsequent rounds will be single elimination.
- Top 2 players from each group in the first round will advance to the next round in Singles events. Only the top pair In Doubles events will advance to the next round.
- Non rated players are not allowed to advance in rating events unless players have an established USATT league rating.
- All matches are 11 points best of 5 games, except for the final match of Open Singles, which will be best of 7 games if asked.
- USATT rules and regulations will be enforced.
- **Depending on the number of players we may have 4 seeds for Open Singles**

- Maximum rating for a single player for U-3000 is 2000, U-3400 is 2100, for U-3800 is 2250.

Event: A player may be removed from an event at any time should the Tournament Committee decide that the player is overqualified. The Tournament Committee also reserves the right to cancel any event if there are insufficient entries. Fees will be refunded for any cancelled events.

Equipment: Only USATT approved equipment will be used; Total 14 Butterfly Centreflod tables and white Nittaku Premium Three star 40+ Balls will be used.

Ratings: For event eligibility, USATT web site published ratings on 02/15/2025 will be used. Seeding will be based on the most current ratings.

PERSONS IN POSITIONS OF AUTHORITY MUST BE FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

Under USATT Safe Sport Policy, persons holding certain **Positions of Authority** must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for Safe Sport (once per year) and undergo a criminal background screen (every two years). The list of Positions of Authority requiring **Full Safe Sport Compliance** is set out in USATT's Safe Sport Policy and the Athlete Safety Section of the USATT Website: <https://www.teamusa.org/usa-table-tennis/athlete-safety/safe-sport>.

USATT COACHING POLICY

All persons who are engaged in **coaching activities** at USATT Affiliated Member Clubs and/or USATT Sanctioned Tournaments, **except parents or legal guardians coaching their own children**, must be **Fully Safe Sport Compliant**, which requires completing SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year and undergoing a criminal background screen every two years.

ADULT PARTICIPANTS REQUIRING SAFESPORT TRAINING

Pursuant to USATT's Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, **ALL Adult Participants** (participants over the age of 18) **who have regular contact with or authority over minor aged athletes** must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year ("SafeSport Trained").

CONTACT USATT TO BECOME SAFESPORT TRAINED AND/OR FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

USATT is pleased to assist USATT Members in the process of becoming SafeSport Trained and/or Fully Safe Sport Compliant. Please contact USATT at Admin@usatt.org for more information and guidance in this process.

MANDATORY REPORTING

There are certain circumstances where **reporting a potential Safe Sport violation is mandatory**. These circumstances include: (i) child abuse; (ii) sexual misconduct; (iii) emotional and physical misconduct; (iv) criminal charges and/or dispositions involving sexual misconduct or misconduct involving minors; (v) any abuse of the Safe Sport process. **Child abuse must be immediately reported to local law enforcement**.
