FOR TOURNAMENT PARTICIPANTS:

6 Butterfly tables will be used, 2 Xiom tables, and 7 Killerspin tables. Balls will be white Butterfly R40+ plastic 3-star balls. Clothing must be mainly non white. USATT membership is required to play.

PRIZES:

There will be trophies for 1st-4th place for each team member in each division. In the first division, there will be the following prize money:

- 1st place: \$800/team
- 2nd place: \$400/team

TEAMS:

The goal will be to have 4-6 teams in each division. Each team must consist of 2 players. If a change of plans happens for your team after submitting entry, the tournament director must be informed by November 24, 2026.

FINDING TEAM MEMBERS:

If you need help in finding team members, please enter on omnipong.com, check omnipong.com, or contact tournament director Shashin Shodhan at shashin@fremonttabletennis.com or at 510-366-5234.

RATINGS/UNRATED PLAYERS:

If any unrated players want to play, their latest league rating will be used for seeding purposes. If an unrated player does not have a league rating, an estimate rating from a USATT certified coach can be used and the coach must email info@fremonttabletennis.com. For seedings, the most recent rating list will be used. Matches will count for USATT tournament rating.

FORMAT:

Each team match will consist of 5 matches: 2 singles, then 1 doubles, and then possibly 1 or 2 more singles. Each singles and doubles match will be best 3 out of 5 to 11 points.

For all matches, the team matches will end when the first team wins 3 matches. Here is the format for each team match where each letter corresponds to a potential player:

Any team that defaults matches without medical reason, injury, or other approved reason from the tournament director will not be eligible for prize money or trophies. If a default happens, that team's results may not count for the standings. The goal is to have 4-6 teams in each division. All teams in the same division will play each other in a giant round robin. Teams will be seeded into divisions based on the average rating of the 2 players on the team. Teams may have initial matches on Saturday morning 9:45 AM facing teams from other divisions. Teams can be relegated or promoted to lower or higher divisions for the rest of their team matches based on the results of these matches. Then the teams will just play in their own divisions.

TIMINGS AND SCHEDULE:

All teams must report to the control desk by 9:20 AM on Saturday, November 28, 2026. Crossovers will begin at 9:45 AM with division play scheduled to begin when crossovers complete. Teams will play division group matches on Saturday and Sunday with finals on Sunday afternoon/evening.

TEAM NAMES:

Team names must be 35 characters or less. The tournament director reserves the right to request a new team name or change the team name if inappropriate.

ENTRIES, DEADLINES, AND FEES:

The price is \$300/team (or \$150/player) plus \$50/team (\$25/player) registration fee with registration waived with early bird entry. Entries must be postmarked with check payable to Fremont Table Tennis Academy and mailed to Fremont Table Tennis Academy, 47998 Warm Springs Blvd, Fremont, CA 94539 and must be received with payment by the respective entry dates or paid online at <http://omnipong.com> by October 15, 2026 (for early bird) or November 22, 2026 (regular entry) or November 25, 2026 (late entry).

LATE ENTRIES:

Late entries may be accepted with a \$50/team late fee (\$25/player) after November 22, 2026, space permitting. All late entries with payment must be received by Wednesday, November 25, 2026.

REFUNDS:

There are no refunds after November 13, 2026.

SPECTATORS:

There is free entry for spectators, coaches, friends, and family.

USATT SAFE SPORT PROTOCOL
ENTRY BLANK TEMPLATE FOR USATT SANCTIONED TOURNAMENTS

I understand USATT's Safe Sport Policy including the organization's Coaching Policy, which requires that all persons who are engaged in coaching activities at USATT Affiliated Member Clubs and/or USATT Sanctioned Tournaments, except parents or legal guardians coaching their own children, must be fully Safe Sport Compliant, which includes completing SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year and undergoing a criminal background screen every two years.

I understand that, pursuant to USATT's Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, all participants at USATT Sanctioned Tournaments who are over the age of 18 and have **regular contact with or authority over** minor athletes must complete annual SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport.

PERSONS IN POSITIONS OF AUTHORITY MUST BE FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

Under USATT Safe Sport Policy, persons holding certain **Positions of Authority** must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for Safe Sport (once per year) and undergo a criminal background screen (every two years). The list of Positions of Authority requiring **Full Safe Sport Compliance** is set out in USATT's Safe Sport Policy and the Athlete Safety Section of the USATT Website: <https://www.teamusa.org/usa-table-tennis/athlete-safety/safe-sport>.

USATT COACHING POLICY

All persons who are engaged in **coaching activities** at USATT Affiliated Member Clubs and/or USATT Sanctioned Tournaments, **except parents or legal guardians coaching their own children**, must be **Fully Safe Sport Compliant**, which requires completing SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year and undergoing a criminal background screen every two years.

ADULT PARTICIPANTS REQUIRING SAFESPORT TRAINING

Pursuant to USATT's Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, **ALL Adult Participants** (participants over the age of 18) **who have regular contact with or authority over minor aged athletes** must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year ("SafeSport Trained").

CONTACT USATT TO BECOME SAFESPORT TRAINED AND/OR FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

USATT is pleased to assist USATT Members in the process of becoming SafeSport Trained and/or Fully Safe Sport Compliant. Please contact USATT at Admin@usatt.org for more information and guidance in this process.

MANDATORY REPORTING

There are certain circumstances where **reporting a potential Safe Sport violation is mandatory**. These circumstances include: (i) child abuse; (ii) sexual misconduct; (iii) emotional and physical misconduct; (iv) criminal charges and/or dispositions involving sexual misconduct or misconduct involving minors; (v) any abuse of the Safe Sport process. **Child abuse must be immediately reported to local law enforcement**. 1. IN CONSIDERATION of being permitted to participate in any way in USA Table Tennis sanctioned events, I and/or my minor child, our personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin:

ACKNOWLEDGE, agree, and represent that I and/or my minor understand the nature of Table Tennis Activities and that I and/or my minor child are qualified, in good health, and in proper physical condition to participate in such Activity. I further agree that if at any time I believe conditions or equipment to be unsafe, I and/or my minor child will immediately discontinue further participation in the Activity.

3. FULLY UNDERSTAND that (a) TABLE TENNIS ACTIVITIES INVOLVE RISKS AND DANGERS OF SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING PERMANENT DISABILITY, PARALYSIS AND DEATH, HARASSMENT, EXPOSURE TO INAPPROPRIATE CONDUCT AND LANGUAGE ("RISKS"); (b) these Risks and dangers may be caused by me and/or my child's own actions, or inaction, or the actions or inaction of others participating in the Activity, the condition in which the Activity takes place, or THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE "RELEASEES" NAMED BELOW; (c) there may be OTHER RISKS AND SEVERE SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC LOSSES either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I FULLY ACCEPT AND ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS AND ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSSES, COSTS, AND DAMAGES I and/or my minor child incur as a result of my participation in the Activity.

4. HEREBY ACCEPT AND ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, KNOWN AND UNKNOWN, AND ASSUME ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE LOSSES, COSTS, AND/OR DAMAGES FOLLOWING SUCH INJURY, DISABILITY, PARALYSIS, OR DEATH, EVEN IF CAUSED, IN WHOLE OR IN PART, BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE "RELEASEES" NAMED BELOW;

5. HEREBY RELEASE, DISCHARGE, AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE USA TABLE TENNIS, their respective administrators, directors, agents, officers, officials, volunteers, and employees, other participants, any sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises on which the Activity takes place, (each considered one of the "RELEASEES" herein) FROM ALL LIABILITY, CLAIMS, DEMANDS, LOSSES, OR DAMAGES ON MY ACCOUNT CAUSED OR ALLEGED TO BE CAUSED IN WHOLE OR IN PART BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE "RELEASEES" OR OTHERWISE, INCLUDING NEGLIGENT RESCUE OPERATIONS; AND I FURTHER AGREE that if, despite this RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT I and/or my minor child, or anyone on my and/or my minor child's behalf, makes a claim against any of the Releases, I WILL INDEMNIFY, SAVE, AND HOLD HARMLESS EACH OF THE RELEASEES from any litigation expenses, attorney fees, loss, liability, damage, or cost which may incur as the result of such claim.
