Players will compete in their normal divisions with players at the same level. However, within each division, there will be a handicap system to make the matches more challenging. For example, if a 2100 player plays against a 2300 player, the 2100 player will begin each game with a 2-0 lead. The handicap is 1 point per 100 points (6 point limit). The structure and format is exactly the same as a normal league night.

### April 27<sup>th</sup> - Challenge the Champ Night

The league night will continue as normal from 6-8:45pm. At 8pm, there will be optional challenge matches on table 1 against Samson Dubina. He will play against you with his normal paddle, with the pizza paddle, or with the mini paddle – your choice! If you win 1 game, you will receive a prize.

### May 4<sup>th</sup> - Tournament Night

There will be a fun tournament with prize money in every division. This night will be structured slightly differently and each player will get around 4-8 matches. There will be FREE Snacks and FREE Drinks throughout the night!
