Entry Deadline: 7PM Thursday, May 31, 2018. \$10 late fee if entry is received after deadline, if accepted.

Entry Limits: Only the first 24-28 players entered in each time slot may be accepted. *Enter Early!*

Payments: Cash or checks payable to MDTTC, or via Paypal at Omnipong.com. No Phone Entries. No refund after entry deadline.

Ratings: The latest USATT ratings will be used.

Ratings Events: Rating events are open to ALL players, not just MD Residents.

Tournament Director: Larry Hodges, larry@larrytt.com

Referee: International Umpire & Certified Referee Paul Kovac.

Rules: Sanctioned as a 3-star tournament by USA Table Tennis. All USATT regulations apply, including dress code.

Equipment: Butterfly and JOOLA tables and nets, 3-star G40+ Butterfly balls, red rubber floors. ITTF/USATT approved equipment only.

Eligibility: Rating events are open to all. In other events, players must have lived in Maryland for at least 3 months prior to the tournament.

Military personnel assigned to Maryland and full-time Maryland students are immediately eligible.

Junior Prize Money: All junior prize money are scholarships from HW Global Foundation (hwglobal.org), and must be used towards group or private lessons, training camps and/or equipment purchases at MDTTC.

Doubles Events: The Doubles events are sponsored by PongMobile.com.

Format: All singles events are round robin followed by single elimination. All doubles events are single elimination, unless there are five or fewer entries. Top seeds for each event may be seeded out of round robin, depending on the number of entries. All matches are best 3 of 5, except for semifinals and final of Men's and Women's Singles, which are best 4 of 7. All finals must be played. Playoffs between losing semifinalist will decide third place in events where there is a third-place prize. Director reserves the right to modify or cancel events and/or prize money if there are less than five entries. If so, players will be notified via email the night before the event starts. Match time is default time. Players may not enter two events starting at the same time. Unrated players will not advance out of preliminary groups in rating events unless assigned a rating in advance.

Age Limits: As per USATT rules, junior ages are as of first day of the tournament; senior ages as of Dec. 31.

Membership: Proof of USATT membership is required. Memberships may be purchased at the tournament. Adult membership is \$75/year or \$210/3 years. Junior is \$45/year (17 yrs. or younger) or \$125/3 years (14 yrs. or younger). College student is \$45/year. Household is \$150/year. One-time tournament passes are \$20.

Directions: From the Beltway (I-495), take I-270 North; take exit 11, Montgomery Village Ave. After the first stop light, merge left. Get ready to turn left at the next traffic light on Frederick Ave. (355). Drive 1.2 miles and turn right at Game Preserve Road. Drive about 200 yards and make the first right onto a private road leading to parking lots. Follow the brown Maryland Table Tennis Center sign on your right, up the hill. At the entrance to the 3rd parking lot to your right, you will see another brown MDTTC sign. Follow the arrow and then bear left to the downhill driveway into the parking lot for MDTTC.
