**ELIGIBILITY**: Must be current member of the USATT or other ITTF affiliated association. USATT membership can be purchased with your tournament entry. We will use the current USATT rating system to conduct all draws. UNRATED PLAYERS cannot play in the Team events, but can play in the Giant RR event.

**ENTRY DEADLINE**: All entries must be received by Friday, **December 6**<sup>th</sup>. Late entries, phone entries and walk-ins will only be accepted if space is available and at the director's discretion. Players may enter multiple events. Events with insufficient entries may be cancelled with entry fees fully refunded. Please check-in 30 minutes prior to your event start time

**REGULATIONS**: All USATT regulations apply and USATT approved equipment are to be used. Please refer to the USATT dress code guidelines for clothing/attire.

**VENUE/EQUIPMENT**: 10 STIGA Optimum 30 tables with STIGA Premium VM nets, Nittaku 3-Star Premium 40+ balls made in Japan (white), ITTF-approved red sports flooring and LED lighting on all courts

**CONDUCT**: Follow the sequence of play on the score sheet so you will be aware when you are next up. Please keep your warm-ups limited to two minutes and write down the scores after each game. Following the completion of a RR or a SE match, bring the completed score sheet with the clip board, balls, and pencils used to the control desk.

**FOOD/PARKING**: Paddle Palace Club is located in downtown Tigard on Main Street, 20 minutes from downtown Portland. The venue location offers several restaurants within walking distance and free street parking, in addition to the venue's 35-space parking lot.

**USATT MEMBERSHIP:** Current USATT or other ITTF affiliate membership required of all participants. Basic Membership: \$25/year, Pro Membership: \$75/year.

### **EVENT FORMAT:**

**2-Person Team Events**: Teams will be placed in RR groups of 4 teams. Team ties will be best out of 5 matches with the sequence of play: A vs X, B vs Y, AB vs XY doubles, A vs Y (if necessary), B vs X (if necessary). The top team of each group will advance to the single elimination round.

The 4000 Teams and 3000 Teams events have a maximum of 16 teams (32 players).

**Giant Round Robin:** 50 players maximum.

Round 1 - Players will be placed in RR groups of 5 players.

Round 2 - The top #1 finisher from each RR group in round 1 will be placed in Division A, #2 finisher in Division B, #3 finisher in Division C, #4 finisher in Division D, and #5 finisher in Division E. Players in each division will be split between 2 RR groups of 5 players.

Round 3 - The top finishers from each table in Round 2 will advance to the Finals of their division.

All matches are best of 5 games to 11 points.

### PERSONS IN POSITIONS OF AUTHORITY MUST BE FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

Under USATT Safe Sport Policy, persons holding certain **Positions of Authority** must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for Safe Sport (once per year) and undergo a criminal background screen (every two years). The list of Positions of Authority requiring **Full Safe Sport Compliance** is set out in USATT's Safe Sport Policy and the Athlete Safety Section of the USATT Website: <a href="https://www.teamusa.org/usa-table-tennis/athlete-safety/safe-sport">https://www.teamusa.org/usa-table-tennis/athlete-safety/safe-sport</a>.

#### **USATT COACHING POLICY**

All persons who are engaged in **coaching activities** at USATT Affiliated Member Clubs and/or USATT Sanctioned Tournaments, **except parents or legal guardians coaching their own children**, must be **Fully Safe Sport Compliant**, which requires completing SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year and undergoing a criminal background screen every two years.

### **ADULT PARTICIPANTS REQUIRING SAFESPORT TRAINING**

Pursuant to USATT's Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, <u>ALL Adult Participants</u> (participants over the age of 18) who have regular contact with or authority over minor aged athletes must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year ("SafeSport Trained").

### CONTACT USATT TO BECOME SAFESPORT TRAINED AND/OR FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

USATT is pleased to assist USATT Members in the process of becoming SafeSport Trained and/or Fully Safe Sport Compliant. Please contact USATT at <a href="mailto:Admin@usatt.org">Admin@usatt.org</a> for more information and guidance in this process.

### MANDATORY REPORTING

There are certain circumstances where **reporting a potential Safe Sport violation is mandatory**. These circumstances include: (i) child abuse; (ii) sexual misconduct; (iii) emotional and physical misconduct; (iv) criminal charges and/or dispositions involving sexual misconduct or misconduct involving minors; (v) any abuse of the Safe Sport process. **Child abuse must be immediately reported to local law enforcement.** To learn more about the appropriate agency where you can submit a report of child abuse, log onto: <a href="https://www.childwelfare.gov/topics/responding/reporting.">https://www.childwelfare.gov/topics/responding/reporting.</a>
