- Divisions:

 - ≤1700
 - ≤2000 / Club
 - Open
- 9 matches per division** (45 total)
- 1 point per match win**
- Golden Game**
- 5 bonus points**
- 5 players (one per division) per club
- Race to **31 points**, win by one
- Golden Point if score is 31 all
