UNRATED PLAYERS: (CANNOT ADVANCE OUT OF THE A RATED ROUND ROBIN EVENT. THE OPEN EVENT HAS NO RATING LIMITS).

Unrated players in singles events with defined rating limits will get credit for matches won in the first round in terms of USATT rating point accrual. Unrated players may be seeded in the draw at the sole discretion of the Tournament Director, and by the means/mechanism selected by the Tournament Director, in his/her sole discretion.

DEFAULTS - SPLITS - DUMPS: No prizes will be awarded to players that **splits, dumps, defaults, or no shows**.

Default time is the start time of the event. If you participate in any of these activities/actions, you will not be allowed to play in the following NorthSide TTC Tournament.

EVENT ENTRY FEES: See Event Table for fees, which vary by event.

ALL ONLINE ENTRY PAYMENTS must be received WITHIN 2 CALENDAR DAYS OF REGISTRATION or BEFORE THE CUTOFF DATE WHICH IS 6 DAYS BEFORE THE TOURNAMENT. If payment is not received within this time period, the players will be automatically withdrawn from the event. Late entries may be accepted only at the discretion of the Tournament Director. Registration Policy:

- **All online registrations:** for the tournament are submitted using OMNIPONG.COM. Please read the registration entry form details carefully for each event.
- **Payment in full:** is required for ALL registered events WITHIN 2 CALENDAR DAYS of registration. This includes (USATT membership or renewal fee (if needed), plus late fee (if applicable). IF ENTRIES ARE NOT PAID IN FULL WITHIN 2 DAYS AFTER REGISTRATION THE PLAYER IS DROPPED OUT OF THE EVENT (The day of registration is considered day 1). The player can register again if a spot is available.
- IF NO WEB CONNECTION, **please contact Peter Christofolo at (303) 601- 3415 before sending payment and entry form.** Spots fill up fast. Priority will be given to those who register via the Omping.com system AND who pay in full.
- **Waivers** All participants must sign the waiver (for players under the age of 18 the waivers must be signed by a parent or legal guardian) before beginning play.

NOTE: Accounts will be charged a \$25 fee for returned checks. Participants with declined payment will be withdrawn from the tournament.

Refund Policy:

- An administrative fee of \$15 will be deducted from ALL REFUNDS that happen more than 7 days before tournament. ➤ REFUNDS may take up to 4 weeks to process.
- **There will be NO REFUNDS for participants who withdraw or cancel less than 7 calendar days before the tournament.** For example, if the tournament starts on a Saturday, then entry fees are non-refundable starting on the previous Sunday. In this case, requests for refunds would have to be submitted by the previous Saturday.
- Events which are cancelled for insufficient entries; or cancelled due to illness or inability of **Colorado NorthSide Table Tennis** or the Tournament Director to hold the tournament, then entry fees will be refunded.
- **Cancellation without Fault:** There will be a 50% refund if the tournament is cancelled due to acts of God, force majeure, war, governmental authority, natural disasters, terrorism or civil disorder.
- To receive refund **a written/verbal withdrawal / cancellation request** MUST be submitted by the tournament player/ legal guardian or parent to the Tournament Director. Please include **your name, phone number, and**

the events you wish to be withdrawn from.

General Information

Event Limitations: This tournament has a limited number of players or teams allowed for each event. Complete entries with payment are processed in the order received. Once an event is full (based on a target number set at the discretion of the Tournament Director), that event will be closed, and no further entries accepted. Entering early will give you a better chance of getting into an event before it is full.

Waitlists: If an event is FULL at the time you register, there is a waitlist available. There is **no charge** to be put on the waitlist. You will be notified if a spot becomes available. There will be **ONE ATTEMPT** to contact you by PHONE and/or TEXT if a spot becomes available. If a spot does not become available, I will try to notify you by email or text. You also can remove yourself from the waitlist if you wish not to be considered for a place in the tournament.

➤ **NOTE: HOW ARE WAIT LISTED PLAYERS SELECTED: RATING QUALIFIED - DATE AND TIME YOU ENTER THE WAIT LIST.**

➤ **NOTE: If a player is bumped out of an event because of a rating increase, she/he will move to first position on the appropriate wait list.**

➤ **NOTE: The TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR reserves the right to select a player off the wait-list out of order listed** not have a USATT rating, an estimated USATT rating will be assigned based upon a recommendation by a coach who knows the player or by visual evaluation of the player by a coach, whenever possible.

➤ All entrant agrees to abide by USATT regulations and decisions of the tournament officials. **in the above notes.**

No-Show Policy: Players who are not present at match start time for any event **forfeit their position and entry fees** for that event. Players may not be allowed to enter future competitions.

Dress Code: USATT Dress Code will be enforced in all cases as determined by the Tournament Referee. Please do not wear clothing that contains any colors, or colors in a design, or reflective objects that are not approved by USATT, this includes big designs/numbers, long pants, tank tops, and hats. Players/spectators wearing clothing that may reach the level of being considered offensive or distracting, they will be asked to change clothes or leave the playing area. **Note:** This will include anything that contains a **WHITE** color in the design.

Rules: All USATT Regulations apply, and all participants must abide by the decisions of the tournament staff and officials. Colorado NorthSide Table Tennis Rules will also be enforced; violators may be asked to leave. If ejected due to violation of Event Center rules, the player will be defaulted automatically, and no fee refunds will be issued. We are here to support the players. Distractions of any kind will not be tolerated. The tournament director has the final say in these matters. **An Event with fewer than four (4) registered participants may be cancelled at the discretion of the tournament director.**

Equipment: All USATT Regulations Apply. Only USATT/ITTF approved equipment will be used. Tables will be Joola 3000SC blue color with Joola WM net sets. The floor is all covered with gymnasium wood flooring. Balls will be **Nittaku** white 40+ premium competition poly balls.

USATT Ratings: Ratings as posted on USATT website approximately FOUR (4) weeks before the tournament are used for USATT rated events.

USATT Membership: Players must have a currently active USATT membership to play in USATT sanctioned events. Players without a currently active membership at the time of registration must include their USATT registration or renewal fees along with their tournament event fees when submitting payment. Please see the USATT membership page for more details on membership options and rates.

Required USATT Statements:

- Events with insufficient entries may be cancelled at the discretion of Denver Northside Table Tennis. Fees managed as outlined in the refund policy.
- If a rating event is cancelled, the player will automatically be placed in the next highest rating event (only if applicable based on tournament format). Not applicable in teams' tournaments.
- The current USATT rating system will be used for the purposes of conducting all draws. For players that do

- 1. ACKNOWLEDGE**, agree, and represent that I and/or my minor understand the nature of Table Tennis Activities and that I and/or my minor child are qualified, in good health, and in proper physical condition to participate in such Activity. I further agree that if at any time I believe conditions or equipment to be unsafe, I and/or my minor child will immediately discontinue further participation in the Activity.
- 2. FULLY UNDERSTAND** that (a) TABLE TENNIS ACTIVITIES INVOLVE RISKS AND DANGERS OF SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING PERMANENT DISABILITY, PARALYSIS AND DEATH, HARASSMENT, EXPOSURE TO INAPPROPRIATE CONDUCT AND LANGUAGE ("RISKS"); (b) these Risks and dangers may be caused by me and/or my child's own actions, or inaction, or the actions or inaction of others participating in the Activity, the condition in which the Activity takes place, or THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE "RELEASEES" NAMED BELOW; (c) there may be OTHER RISKS AND SEVERE SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC LOSSES either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I FULLY ACCEPT AND ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS AND ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSSES, COSTS, AND DAMAGES I and/or my minor child incur as a result of my participation in the Activity.

PERSONS IN POSITIONS OF AUTHORITY MUST BE FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

Under USATT Safe Sport Policy, persons holding certain Positions of Authority must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for Safe Sport (once per year) and undergo a criminal background screen (every two years). USATT COACHING POLICY All persons who are engaged in **coaching activities** at USATT Affiliated Member Clubs and/or USATT Sanctioned Tournaments, **except parents or legal guardians coaching their own children**, must be **Fully Safe Sport Compliant**, which requires completing SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year and undergoing a criminal background screen every two years.

ADULT PARTICIPANTS REQUIRING SAFESPORT TRAINING

Pursuant to USATT's Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, **ALL Adult Participants** (participants over the age of 18) **who have regular contact with or authority over minor aged athletes** must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year ("SafeSport Trained").

CONTACT USATT TO BECOME SAFESPORT TRAINED AND/OR FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

USATT is pleased to assist USATT Members in the process of becoming SafeSport Trained and/or Fully Safe Sport Compliant. Please contact USATT at Admin@usatt.org for more information and guidance in this process.

MANDATORY REPORTING

There are certain circumstances where **reporting a potential Safe Sport violation is mandatory**. These circumstances include: (i) child abuse; (ii) sexual misconduct; (iii) emotional and physical misconduct; (iv) criminal charges and/or dispositions involving sexual misconduct or misconduct involving minors; (v) any abuse of the Safe Sport process. **Child abuse must be immediately reported to local law enforcement**.
