Conductor: ITTF Course Conductor/Trainer, Christian Lillieroos will conduct the course. Coach Lillieroos is one of the most experienced course conductors in the World. Coach Christian is the only conductor in the world certified for level 1, 2 and 3 courses to teach in both English and Spanish.

Host: USA Table Tennis

Eligibility: Applications for the ITTF Level 2 Course are open to coaches who meet the following requirements:

- For ITTF Level 2, participants need to be currently listed on the ITTF Coaches Registry as ITTF Level 1 coach
- Attended an ITTF Level 1 Course with a start date before February 2023
- If participants do not have ITTF certification, then they may take same course for USATT Regional Level Coach

Course Description

The ITTF Level 2 Coaching Course is a 36-hour course held over six days with lecturing, and practical part split into two sessions of three hours each day. The course material and syllabus are in the ITTF Advanced Manual (<http://www.paddlepalace.com/Table-Tennis-Advanced-Coaching-Manual/productinfo/MMBA/>). Level 2 material is much more complex than Level 1. It is recommended that participants purchase the manual in advance so they can study before arrival. ITTF Level 2 course prepares coaches to teach technical skills level to fulfill the needs of athletes from 1800 to 2400 in USATT ratings.

ITTF Level 2 Coaching Course is approved by the ITTF and has the following requirements:

1. Attendance of 36 hours during the course conducted by an ITTF-approved Course Conductor
2. Passing a verbal and practical exam

Grading and additional requirements:

The test has two parts - verbal and practical. There are 20 points for both parts of the test (10 points each). Coaches must score at least 5 points on each part of the test to pass the Level 2. Coaches who score a minimum of 7 points on both exams and 15 points would be listed as ITTF Level 2 coaches and are eligible to take an ITTF Level 3 Course in the future.

For the ITTF Level 2 certification after the course, 50 hours of coaching practice must be completed. From the 50 hours of coaching, 5 hours must be supervised by the ITTF Course Conductor or a person

appointed by the ITTF Course Conductor. For the USATT Regional level, as practical part, coaches would coach in the National Team camps, Developmental Team camps or the Performance Center in Charlotte, NC.
