All players must show proof of USATT Pro Membership at the time of registration. Renewals will be sold at the event.  All Registration will be conducted through <a href="http://www.OmniPong.com">www.OmniPong.com</a>  All matches will count towards USATT Rating and USATT Ranking and for US National Team Ranking.  Deadline for registration: May 22, 2024.  Entries will be accepted only if they include entry fee, signed waiver and proof of citizenship	Only players who are a US Citizen and can represent the US at the 2024 Pan Am Championships according to the ITTF eligibility rules, can compete at the 2024 US Adult National Team Trials.  Only USATT members in good standing may participate. Players need to be <b>current USATT Pro Members</b> . Signed USATT National Team Code of Conduct forms and Waiver will be required by all participants. Players will be required to provide a copy of their current passport or birth certificate to prove eligibility.  <b>Please note: If a player has already registered with the ITTF or played National Team Trials for another country, such player is not eligible to enter this tournament.</b>	I understand USATT's Safe Sport Policy including the organization's Coaching Policy, which requires that all persons who are engaged in coaching activities at USATT Affiliated Member Clubs and/or USATT Sanctioned Tournaments, except parents or legal guardians coaching their own children, must be fully Safe Sport Compliant, which includes completing SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year and undergoing a criminal background screen every two years. **SYSTEM OF PLAY**

**STAGE 1 - Day 1**

- \* The numbers 1 through 8 from the seeding list will go directly into stage 2
- \* The stage 1 round will be played in a multiple elimination knock out format
- \* Maximum of 16 players can qualify through this stage for stage 2
- \* All matches will be best of 5
- \* Draw is created by snake system using the latest available USATT ratings
- \* When there are 24 players or less entered then stage 1 will not be played

**STAGE 2 - Day 1 and Day 2 (MAX 24 PLAYERS)**

- \* Maximum of 16 players through stage 1 will play in stage 2
- \* four round robin groups of maximum 6 players will be played if there are more than 12 players entered in an event
- \* two round robin groups of maximum 6 players will be played if there are more than 7 and less than 13 players entered in an event
- \* the top four players of each round robin group will advance to stage 3 if there are more than 20 players entered in the total event
- \* the top three players of each round robin group will advance to stage 3 if there are more than 7 but less than 21 players entered in the total event
- \* if there are less than 8 players entered in the total event then stage 2 will not be played
- \* All matches will be best of 5
- \* Draw is created by snake system based on results of stage 1, numbers 1 through 8 from the seeding list will get positions 1 through 8 in the draw of stage 2

**STAGE 3 - Day 2 and Day 3 (MAX 16 PLAYERS)**

- \* Maximum of 16 players qualified through stage 2 will play in stage 3
- \* A main draw of maximum 16 players will be played, where players will be seeded into different rounds of the main draw according to their results in stage 2
- \* The numbers 1,2,3 and 4 from the same round robin in stage 2 will be drawn into 4 separate quarters of the draw
- \* First round in the main draw will be a match between a number 3 and a number 4 from the round robin groups in stage 2, losers of these matches will be eliminated
- \* Second round in the main draw will be a match between a winner of the first round match and a number 2 from the round robin groups in stage 2, losers of these matches will be eliminated
- \* Third round in the main draw will be a match between a winner of a 2nd round match and a number 1 from the round robin groups in stage 2, losers of these matches will be playing for the final ranking order of numbers 3 through 8
- \* Fourth round in the main draw will be two matches (semi finals) between winners of the 3rd round matches, losers of these matches will be playing for the final ranking order of numbers 3 through 6
- \* Fifth round in the main draw will be a match between the winners of the 4th round matches (finals), winner of this match will be first in the final ranking order and the loser will be 2nd in the final ranking order
- \* If there are less than 21 players entered then the rounds of the main draw will be adjusted accordingly
- \* Every position from 3 through 8 will be played for through the losers bracket
- \* All matches will be best of 7
- \* Draw is created based on results of stage 2, see the schedule below, where every quarter of the draw has only one player from the same round robin group in stage 2
- \* If there are less than 8 players entered in the total event then stage 3 will be played as a round robin

If there is one or more US Players in the Top 50 from the world singles ranking on the date announced in the entry form then the highest player in the Top 50 will be ranked number 1 in the 3rd adult trials 2024 if the player enters for the 3rd trials adults 2024

If there is one or more US Players entered in the 3rd trials adults 2024 who are invited to participate in the WTT Champions in Chongching (China) then the invited players will be ranked number 1 and/or 2 in the 3rd trials adults 2024
