
# **Rules and Regulations**

- 1. Tournament management may modify, combine, or cancel events, limit total entrants, or total entries by event. Fees for cancelled events will be refunded.
- 2. USATT dress code & all other USATT rules will be enforced.
- 3. All events will be on EST (Eastern Standard Time) and be 3 out of 5 game matches. Enter Early...
- 4. Hard-bat Open will be 2 out of 3 games to 21.
- 5. USATT accepted Hard-bat rules and regulations will be followed for Event #4.
- **6.** Any event starting after 4 PM on Saturday MAY carryover final rounds to Sunday.
- 7. DO NOT ENTER 2 events with same starting time or more than 6 total events.
- **8.** Unrated players may enter any event; however, they will **NOT** advance from any rated restricted round robin.
- **9.** All events with the exception of Event #4 are open to USATT members or those who join. Event #4 is open to any and all players. Ratings will be used as available for seeding.
- 10. Age cutoff for 40 & over / 50 & over is your age as of 12/31/2025. Age cutoff for any junior events is 3/22/2025.
- 11. Ratings as of 1/31/2025 will be used for eligibility. Ratings for seeding will be from 3/19/2025.
- 12. Withdrawals up through 3/18/2025 will be eligible for full refunds.
- 13. Any image, photographic or otherwise, of tournament play or within the official venue is the joint property of USA Table Tennis (USATT) and SBTTC. Entrants agree to allow their voice, image, likeness, and/or any other representation to be broadcast, reproduced, or publicized by way of any medium as determined by USATT and/or SBTTC.

- 15. Some events will fill quickly, so ENTER EARLY!
- 16. Mail Entry Deadline: Postmark by Friday, 3/07/25, (With payment)
- 17. Event #29 is a non-sanctioned event. (14U age limit) No USATT membership required.

### PERSONS IN POSITIONS OF AUTHORITY MUST BE FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT.

Under USATT Safe Sport Policy, persons holding certain Positions of Authority must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for Safe Sport (once per year) and undergo a criminal background screen (every two years). The list of Positions of Authority requiring Full Safe Sport Compliance is set out in USATT's Safe Sport Policy and the Athlete Safety Section of the USATT Website: https://www.teamusa.org/usa-table-tenris/athlete-safety/safe-sport.

#### USATT COACHING POLICY

All persons who are engaged in coaching activities at USATT Affiliated Member Clubs and/or USATT Sanctioned Tournaments, except parents or legal guardians coaching their own children, must be Fully Safe Sport Compliant, which requires completing SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year and undergoing a criminal background screen every two years.

## ADULT PARTICIPANTS REQUIRING SAFESPORT TRAINING

Pursuant to USATT's Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, <u>ALL Adult Participants</u> (participants over the age of 18) who have regular contact with or authority over minor aged athletes must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year ("SafeSport Trained").

## CONTACT USATT TO BECOME SAFESPORT TRAINED AND/OR FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

USATT is pleased to assist USATT Members in the process of becoming SafeSport Trained and/or Fully Safe Sport Compliant. Please contact USATT at Admin@usatt.org for more information and guidance in this process.

# MANDATORY REPORTING

There are certain circumstances where reporting a potential Safe Sport violation is mandatory. These circumstances include: (i) child abuse; (ii) sexual misconduct; (iii) emotional and physical misconduct; (iv) criminal charges and/or dispositions involving sexual misconduct or misconduct involving minors; (v) any abuse of the Safe Sport process. Child abuse must be immediately reported to local law enforcement.
