2<sup>nd</sup> place finish in First Stage will go to Division B Round Robin Group 3<sup>rd</sup> place finish in First Stage will go to Division C Round Robin Group

4th along finish in Pirst Stage will go to Division C Round Robin Group

 $4^{\text{th}}$  place finish in First Stage will go to Division D Round Robin Group

5<sup>th</sup> place finish in First Stage will go to Division E Round Robin Group

6th place finish in First Stage will go to Division F Round Robin Group

Top two finishes in the Second Stage from each group will advance to play in Semi-Finals and Finals.

**Gold Dollar:** 

This tournament is unique because money can be won by all level of players; not just the top players. The only criteria to win gold dollars is to upset a player whose USATT rating is higher than yours. The rules for winning are:

- 1. Gold Dollars will be paid to winners of all upsets, regardless of player's rating.
- 2. Winners of each upset will receive gold dollars using the following payout schedule:

Rating difference: 100 or less, Gold Dollar reward: \$5.00 Rating difference: 101 to 150, Gold Dollar reward: \$10.00 Rating difference: 150 or larger, Gold Dollar reward: \$15.00

- 3. The gold dollars will be paid immediately upon confirmation of match sheets showing upsets on a first come first get paid basis until the funds run out. KTTC reserves \$200 Gold Dollars for this payout. So sharpen your game and hit the court running fast!
- 4. Rating used to determine the upsets will be the USATT ratings of record as of 09:00 a.m. Friday October 4<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Only USATT rated players prior to the date of the tournament are eligible to win gold dollars.
- 5. Both players must be officially rated before the tournament to earn Gold Dollar, i.e. any match involved an unrated players will not receive Gold Dollar.

# <u>USATT SAFE SPORT POLICY TEMPLATE</u> ENTRY BLANK TEMPLATE FOR USATT SANCTIONED TOURNAMENTS

I understand USATT's Safe Sport Policy including the organization's Coaching Policy, which requires that all persons who are engaged in coaching activities at USATT Affiliated Member Clubs and/or USATT Sanctioned Tournaments, except parents or legal guardians coaching their own children, must be fully Safe Sport Compliant, which includes completing SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year and undergoing a criminal background screen every two years.
I understand that, pursuant to USATT's Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, all participants at USATT Sanctioned Tournaments who are over the age of 18 and have <u>regular contact with or authority over</u> minor athletes must complete annual SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport.
