All matches will be the best of 5 games and 11 points each. Singles Round Robin, with the top 2 advancing to single elimination.

**EQUIPMENT:** USATT approved. 20 Butterfly Centrefold 25 tables, nets set: Butterfly Europa, blue Chinese PVC flooring, Butterfly R40+ three-star white balls (donated by Bowmar Sports) **CLOTHING:** USATT dress code applies.

**RATING ELIGIBILITY DATE:** 09/14/24. The tournament committee may estimate ratings for unrated players, who are then eligible to advance to single elimination

**ENTRY DEADLINE:** Singles: September 23<sup>rd</sup> / Teams September 28<sup>th</sup>.

Will be conducted in one stage. Players are ranked according to USATT rating and placed 4 classes of 10 players (or lesser number of players if tournament is not full)
Cost: \$40. Prizes: Class "A" 1st. \$250 / 2nd \$125. Class "B" 1st. \$150 / 2nd \$75. Class "C" and "D" 1st. \$100 / 2nd \$50. Trophies for 1st and 2nd places.

**TEAM FORMAT:** Each team can have 2 to 3 players. For rating purposes, we will add the top two players. Two players will play in the singles and the third one can play doubles in each tie. It will be a round robin competition. It will be played two singles, then the doubles and the reverse singles if necessary. Once a team has three wins the tie is over.

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## USATT SAFE SPORT PROTOCOL ENTRY BLANK TEMPLATE FOR USATT SANCTIONED TOURNAMENTS

I understand USATT's Safe Sport Policy including the organization's Coaching Policy, which requires that all persons who are engaged in coaching activities at USATT Affiliated Member Clubs and/or USATT Sanctioned Tournaments, except parents or legal guardians coaching their own children, must be fully Safe Sport Compliant, which includes completing SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year and undergoing a criminal background screen every two years.
I understand that, pursuant to USATT's Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, all participants at USATT Sanctioned Tournaments who are over the age of 18 and have <u>regular contact</u> with or <u>authority over</u> minor athletes must complete annual SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport.

### PERSONS IN POSITIONS OF AUTHORITY MUST BE FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

Under USATT Safe Sport Policy, persons holding certain **Positions of Authority** must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for Safe Sport (once per year) and undergo a criminal background screen (every two years). The list of Positions of Authority requiring **Full Safe Sport Compliance** is set out in USATT's Safe Sport Policy and the Athlete Safety Section of the USATT Website: <a href="https://www.teamusa.org/usa-table-tennis/athlete-safety/safe-sport">https://www.teamusa.org/usa-table-tennis/athlete-safety/safe-sport</a>.

### USATT COACHING POLICY

All persons who are engaged in **coaching activities** at USATT Affiliated Member Clubs and/or USATT Sanctioned Tournaments, **except parents or legal guardians coaching their own children**, must be **Fully Safe Sport Compliant**, which requires completing SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year and undergoing a criminal background screen every two years.

### ADULT PARTICIPANTS REQUIRING SAFESPORT TRAINING

Pursuant to USATT's Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, <u>ALL Adult Participants</u> (participants over the age of 18) who have regular contact with or authority over minor aged athletes must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year ("SafeSport Trained").

### CONTACT USATT TO BECOME SAFESPORT TRAINED AND/OR FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

USATT is pleased to assist USATT Members in the process of becoming SafeSport Trained and/or Fully Safe Sport Compliant. Please contact USATT at Admin@usatt.org for more information and guidance in this process.

### MANDATORY REPORTING

There are certain circumstances where **reporting a potential Safe Sport violation is mandatory**. These circumstances include: (i) child abuse; (ii) sexual misconduct; (iii) emotional and physical misconduct; (iv) criminal charges and/or dispositions involving sexual misconduct or misconduct involving minors; (v) any abuse of the Safe Sport process. **Child abuse must be immediately reported to local law enforcement.** To learn more about the appropriate agency where you can submit a report of child abuse, log onto: <a href="https://www.childwelfare.gov/topics/responding/reporting">https://www.childwelfare.gov/topics/responding/reporting</a>.
