Format	 Open Singles: Preliminary pools of 3 or 4 players, with the first-place finisher advancing to Division 1, 2nd place to Division 2, 3rd place to Division 3 and 4th place to Division 4. Each of the subsequent divisions will be single elimination. Open Doubles: The format will be preliminary groups with all teams advancing to either Division 1 (1st and 2nd place finishers) or Division 2 (3rd and 4th place finishers), where matches will be single elimination. Age Events: Single elimination.
	Seedings will be made according to current ITTF ranking, USATT rating, CTTA rating, or alternative rating systems (e.g. Ratings Central) or other national classification system. The top 8 to 16 players will be seeded and all others will be placed randomly in the preliminary pool. The geographic separation of players will be observed to the greatest extent possible. The tournament committee reserves the right to amend the format as necessary, depending on the number of entries.
Scorekeeping	All matches will have scorekeepers. The loser of a match must remain at the table and keep score for the subsequent match. No exceptions.
Prizes	Monetary prizes will be paid by cash or check. The merchandise prizes will be nice.
