ENTRY DEADLINE: All entries must be RECEIVED BY September 20th, 2024. Late entries may or may not be accepted with a \$15 late fee. No refund after the deadline. No entry will be accepted without an entry form (online or mailed) and payment. **ELIGIBILITY:** A 3-star USATT sanctioned tournament. Proof of USATT membership required for all events. Rating will be processed through USATT.

FORMAT: Singles events will start with preliminary round robin (RR) of 3 or 4 players followed by a single elimination (SE) main draw. One or two players will advance from the preliminary RR depending on the number of entrants. Format subject to change based on actual number of players.

EQUIPMENT: White Butterfly 3-Star Ball R40+ will be used. 10 ITTF Approved Butterfly tables will be used. ITTF approved red rubber floor mat on all courts.

ENTRY FEE: Open Singles: \$50. Doubles: \$30/player, for all other events \$40 per event, Early Bird \$5 off per event sign up and paid by August 15th, 2024. Entries must be fully paid.

RULES:

- All USATT regulations, including equipment, conduct, dress, and language, apply.
- All matches are best of 5 games to 11 points except semifinals and final of the Open Singles, which are best of 7 to 11.
- It is recommended that players bring two legal rackets.
- Players must arrive at least 30 minutes before the event starting time.
- * Ratings as of August 16th, 2024 on the USATT website will be used to establish eligibility. The most recent rating will be used for seeding. Estimated ratings for new players may be accepted from USATT certified coaches or the tournament director for seeding purpose. Un-rated players may or may not advance from the RR's in the rating events at tournament referee's discretion.
- Seniors for age event must be over the age bracket as of 9/28/2024.
- ❖ Juniors for age event must be under 10 years old on August 1st, 2024.
- ❖ All decisions made by tournament referee or director will be final.
- Prize(s) may be forfeited if the match is not played unless approved by the tournament director.
- Events may be canceled or combined if needed. In the event of cancelation, fees will be refunded.

PERSONS IN POSITIONS OF AUTHORITY MUST BE FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

Under USATT Safe Sport Policy, persons holding certain **Positions of Authority** must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for Safe Sport (once per year) and undergo a criminal background screen (every two years). The list of Positions of Authority requiring **Full Safe Sport Compliance** is set out in USATT's Safe Sport Policy and the Athlete Safety Section of the USATT Website: https://www.teamusa.org/usa-table-tennis/athlete-safety/safe-sport.

USATT COACHING POLICY

All persons who are engaged in **coaching activities** at USATT Affiliated Member Clubs and/or USATT Sanctioned Tournaments, **except parents or legal guardians coaching their own children**, must be **Fully Safe Sport Compliant**, which requires completing SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year and undergoing a criminal background screen every two years.

ADULT PARTICIPANTS REQUIRING SAFESPORT TRAINING

Pursuant to USATT's Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, <u>ALL Adult Participants</u> (participants over the age of 18) who have regular contact with or authority over minor aged athletes must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year ("SafeSport Trained").

CONTACT USATT TO BECOME SAFESPORT TRAINED AND/OR FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

USATT is pleased to assist USATT Members in the process of becoming SafeSport Trained and/or Fully Safe Sport Compliant. Please contact USATT at Admin@usatt.org for more information and guidance in this process.

MANDATORY REPORTING

There are certain circumstances where reporting a potential Safe Sport violation is mandatory. These circumstances include: (i) child abuse; (ii) sexual misconduct; (iii) emotional and physical misconduct; (iv) criminal charges and/or dispositions involving sexual misconduct or misconduct involving minors; (v) any abuse of the Safe Sport process. Child abuse must be immediately reported to local law enforcement.
