Butterfly R40+ balls, and wood floor.

Rules: USATT Rules including dress code shall be enforced. The main color
of the body of the shirt, shorts, or skirt may not be white. Rubber-soled, non-
marking shoes must be worn.

Eligibility: Open to all USATT members. Non-members may enter tournament
by purchasing a USATT Silver or Gold membership to play. Non-rated
players may enter the tournament and play, but they will NOT be eligible to
receive cash prizes.

To Enter: Register via Omnipong.com, online entry only.

Entry Fee: \$45 per player.

Entry Deadline: August 12 ,2026. No refund will be granted after August 12,
2026.

Start Time: Doors open and check-in begins at 9:00. Tournament play begins at 10:00.

Format: This is a single-round event with four groups/divisions of 10 players per round-robin group. Players will be placed/seeded in divisions based on USATT rating as of August 12, 2026.

Player entry fees will be refunded upon the Tournament Director's receipt of a player's written request before the deadline. No refunds will be granted after the deadline
