USATT SAFE SPORT PROTOCOL – ENTRY FORM NOTICE
FOR USATT SANCTIONED TOURNAMENTS

I understand USATT’s Safe Sport Policy, including the Coaching Policy, which requires that anyone engaged in coaching activities at USATT Affiliated Member Clubs and/or USATT Sanctioned Tournaments—except parents or legal guardians coaching their own children—must be fully Safe Sport compliant. This includes completing SafeSport Training offered by the U.S. Center for SafeSport every year and undergoing a criminal background screen every two years.

I also understand that, under USATT’s Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, all participants at USATT Sanctioned Tournaments who are over 18 years old and have regular contact with, or authority over, minor athletes must complete annual SafeSport Training offered by the U.S. Center for SafeSport.
