**Location:** <u>Waimea Community Center</u> in Beautiful <u>Waimea</u>, center of the <u>Big Island of Hawai'i</u>. Easy to get to from Kona or Hilo Airport; less than 30 minute drive from the Golden Sunny Kohala Coast & it's <u>4 & 5 Star Resorts</u>; 2500 foot elevation; cool clean breezes; walking distance to food court, restaurants, grocery stores, shopping mall & more. Play our tournament and stay a few extra days for a great vacation! Aloha!

Entry Deadline: April 30, 2025. Entries received after this date will <u>only</u> be accepted based on available space and have a late charge No entries will be accepted at Tournament. ENTER EARLY AS TOTAL PLAYERS WILL BE 30. IF YOU ENTER AFTER April 30; ADD LATE FEE of \$15.00.

**Equipment:** Nittaku Plastic 40+ white 3-Star balls. 6 Tournament Tables from XIOM, with barrier between tables. Concrete floor.

**Eligibility:** All players who are current USATT members, renew or join and players that purchase a USATT Tournament Pass. All events have player entry limits, so enter early to avoid disappointment & put on waiting list. Ratings: The most current ratings available will be used for seeding. If UNRATED, Tournament Director will issue you a temporary rating to use in play.

**Restrictions:** After the entry deadline, no refunds. Also, entries received April 8 will be accepted on an available space basis only. Tournament director's decisions are final. All events have player entry limits, so enter early to avoid disappointment & put on waiting list.

<u>SUPER ROUND ROBIN</u> Limit 24 players. Players are put into preliminary round robin groups of at least 3 with players of all levels. <u>ALL</u> players will advance from preliminary round robin to medal round robin groups of 3-6 players, based on win/loss record and number of entrants. <u>We will have 3 -4 skill level groups in medal round</u>. NO ELIMINATIONS. Medal round has players compete against others of their skill level. Minimum number of matches is 4, maximum is 9. Lots of fun.

**Rules:** All USATT rules and dress code will apply. 2 minute maximum warm-up before tournament matches. An umpire will be available, if needed. Tournament director reserves the right to cancel an event or make adjustments based on number of players entered in an event. The entrant agrees to abide by the rules of the USATT and decisions of the tournaments officials and relieves the sponsors, hosting club, and USATT of liability.

Fee Schedule: \$40.00 per player for Super Round Robin, \$15.00 per rated RR Events.

**Prizes:** Cash awarded for 1st and 2nd place winners in Super Round Robin Division A, Awards for 1st and 2nd place in all other events. No prizes will be awarded for splits, dumps, default losses or no shows.

Additional Information: We will have a scoreboard for each table & request that 1 player in round robin that is not *currently* playing a match keep score. We will supply coffee in the morning and lunch.

Center for SafeSport every year and undergoing a criminal background screen every two years.

I understand that, pursuant to USATT's Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, all participants at USATT Sanctioned Tournaments who are over the age of 18 and have <u>regular contact with or authority over</u> minor athletes must complete annual SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport.

#### PERSONS IN POSITIONS OF AUTHORITY MUST BE FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

Under USATT Safe Sport Policy, persons holding certain **Positions of Authority** must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for Safe Sport (once per year) and undergo a criminal background screen (every two years). The list of Positions of Authority requiring **Full Safe Sport Compliance** is set out in USATT's Safe Sport Policy and the Athlete Safety Section of the USATT Website: <u>https://www.teamusa.org/usa-table-tennis/athlete-safety/safe-sport</u>.

#### **USATT COACHING POLICY**

All persons who are engaged in **coaching activities** at USATT Affiliated Member Clubs and/or USATT Sanctioned Tournaments, **except parents or legal guardians coaching their own children**, must be **Fully Safe Sport Compliant**, which requires completing SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year and undergoing a criminal background screen every two years.

#### ADULT PARTICIPANTS REQUIRING SAFESPORT TRAINING

Pursuant to USATT's Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, <u>ALL Adult Participants</u> (participants over the age of 18) who have regular contact with or authority over minor aged athletes must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year ("SafeSport Trained").

#### CONTACT USATT TO BECOME SAFESPORT TRAINED AND/OR FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

USATT is pleased to assist USATT Members in the process of becoming SafeSport Trained and/or Fully Safe Sport Compliant. Please contact USATT at <u>Admin@usatt.org</u> for more information and guidance in this process.

#### MANDATORY REPORTING

There are certain circumstances where **reporting a potential Safe Sport violation is mandatory**. These circumstances include: (i) child abuse; (ii) sexual misconduct; (iii) emotional and physical misconduct; (iv) criminal charges and/or dispositions involving sexual misconduct or misconduct involving minors; (v) any abuse of the Safe Sport process. **Child abuse must be immediately reported to local law enforcement**.
