## Rules and Policies

- All ITTF and additional USATT regulations apply. Only ITTF and USATT approved equipment will be used: 10 blue Butterfly Centerfold Table Tennis Table with net and Joola white 3-star 40+ Prime plastic balls.

- Tournament Software: [www.stadiumcompete.com](http://www.stadiumcompete.com)
- Tournament management reserves the right to modify, combine, or cancel events, limit total participants or total entries by event. If event(s) are cancelled the fees for this event will be refunded.
- To be eligible to enter the Venue and/or participate at the tournament, a person Should be in good standing with the [USATT](#) and [SafeSport Organization](#).
- **Starting from April 4<sup>th</sup>, 2026, players who have not made the entry fee payment will be removed from the participant list automatically and the spot will be made open to the next paying participant. Platforms like Omni Pong and or stadium compete may not reflect the actual list of participants and number of available spots which are maintained separately by CITTA organizing committee**
- Players must register at the desk or check in online at stadium compete no later than 30 minutes before the starting time of their respective event(s). **Default time is the starting time for the event and/or the match time.**
- **No prizes will be awarded for splits, defaults and no-shows. Unrated Players are not eligible to win trophy and prize money in rating events 2-7. If a player defaults a match, then the player is defaulted from the following matches and the event.**
- The Venue will be open for practice/warmup from 7:30 am. Pre-match warm-up will be limited to 2 minutes.
- Draws will be posted online at [www.stadiumcompete.com](http://www.stadiumcompete.com) 15 minutes before the start time of respective events. Single Elimination start time will be announced at the start of the respective events.
- All events will start with a round robin (RR) group of 3 to 4 players followed by Single Elimination. For Events 2-6 **only one (1) rated player advances** out of each RR group to Single Elimination (SE)
- **Except for Open, Unrated players (players playing in their first USATT tournament) cannot advance from group stages to Single Elimination rounds for rated events id's 2-7**
- Unrated players will be given an estimated rating based on a recommendation by a coach who knows the player or by visual evaluation of the player by a coach, whenever possible. Unrated players may not win prize money or trophies except for the Open Event
- Withdrawals through April 11<sup>th</sup>, 2025, will be eligible for full refunds. After that date refunds will only be issued if there is someone on the waiting list who fills the vacated spot and / or other situations approved by USATT. No Refunds for now shows
- Any image, photographic, video or otherwise, taken of the tournament play or within the official venue is essentially the property of CITTA (Chicago International Table Tennis Academy) and

USATT. Entrants agree to allow their picture, video, voice and likeness to be reproduced in connection with CITTA or USATT by way of any medium

- The most recent ratings available will be used for seeding the events
- **Event Eligibility Rating Date is March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026**
- All matches are best of 3 out of the 5 games to 11 points as per ITTF/USATT rules
- No Food allowed inside Field of Play (FOP). Packed items including dry Snacks are fine. Drinks are not allowed inside the courts. Please use the lobby for eating and drinking.
- USATT Dress Code applies. The main body of the shirts, shorts and skirts must be significantly different than the color of the ball (white). **No white shirts, shorts and skirts allowed. Tracksuits, Hoodies, Jeans etc. are not allowed during matches. Only ITTF and USATT approved clothing. Dress Shoes and non-Court shoes not allowed on courts. All Court shoes should have non-marking soles.**
- All Trophies must be picked up at the control desk. Trophy will not be shipped.
- **Items Not Allowed inside the Venue or Field of Play: USOC and USATT** have strict policies which don't allow Players and Spectators to bring Firearms, Tobacco products, Smoking products including E-Cigarettes and Vaping products, Alcohol, VOC glues including around minors. Gluing Racket is not permitted inside the Venue. Persons who violate will be automatically Disqualified and removed from the tournament and Venue.

#### **USATT TOURNAMENT PARTICIPANT WAIVER**

**IN CONSIDERATION of being permitted to participate in any way in USA Table Tennis sanctioned events, I and/or minor child, our personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin, I ACKNOWLEDGE, agree, and represent that I and/or minor-aged child understand the nature of Table Tennis Activities, including but not limited to risks involved in the sport itself together with all risks, known and unknown, associated with gatherings of people ("Activities"), including the exposure to COVID-19, coronavirus, or other infectious organisms or diseases; and that I and/or minor child are qualified, in good health, and in proper physical condition to participate in such Activities. I further agree that if at any time I believe conditions or equipment to be unsafe, I and/or minor child will immediately discontinue further participation in the Activities.**

**FULLY UNDERSTAND that (a) TABLE TENNIS ACTIVITIES INVOLVE RISKS AND DANGERS OF SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING PERMANENT**

**DISABILITY, PARALYSIS, DISMEMBERMENT, AND DEATH ("RISKS"); (b) these Risks and dangers may be caused by me and/or minor child's own actions, or inaction, or the actions or inaction of others participating in the Activities, the condition in which the Activities takes place, or THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE "RELEASEES" NAMED BELOW; (c) there may be OTHER RISKS AND SEVERE SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC LOSSES either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I FULLY ACCEPT AND ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS AND ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSSES, COSTS, AND DAMAGES I and/or minor child incur as a result of my participation in such Activities.**

**HEREBY RELEASE, DISCHARGE, AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE USA TABLE TENNIS, their respective administrators, directors, agents, officers, officials, volunteers, and employees, other participants, any sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises on which the Activities takes place, (each considered one of the "RELEASEES" herein) FROM ALL LIABILITY, CLAIMS, DEMANDS, LOSSES, OR DAMAGES ON MY ACCOUNT CAUSED OR ALLEGED TO BE CAUSED IN WHOLE OR IN PART BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE "RELEASEES" OR OTHERWISE, INCLUDING NEGLIGENT RESCUE OPERATIONS; AND I FURTHER AGREE that if, despite this RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, AND INDEMNITY**

**AGREEMENT I and/or my minor child, or anyone on my and/or my minor child's behalf, makes a claim against any of the Releases, I WILL INDEMNIFY, SAVE, AND HOLD HARMLESS EACH OF THE RELEASEES from any litigation expenses, attorney fees, loss, liability, damage, or cost which may incur as the result of such claim.**

**MEDICAL AND TRANSPORTATION RELEASE – I hereby give consent for the organizers of this table tennis tournament to provide me and/or my minor aged child with athletic trainer and emergency medical treatment. I swear and affirm that I am in good physical condition, and I am not aware of any previous or existing diseases or injury that would result in my being injured. I further acknowledge that I have procured on my own and currently hold valid and adequate insurance for such loss, damage, or injury and if I do not have valid and adequate insurance, I accept full responsibility for the cost of the loss, damage, or injury that might occur as a result of my participation in this table tennis tournament. I give my consent to participate in all emergency transportation associated with activities during this table tennis tournament, in the event I become incapacitated or otherwise not conscious to give direct consent, and I accept full responsibility for all costs associated with all emergency transportation as deemed necessary. Further, as the parent/guardian of a participating minor athlete, I hereby give my consent for complete medical treatment and emergency transportation services as deemed necessary beyond the on-site athletic trainer or emergency medical treatment provided.**

**MEDIA AND PHOTO RELEASE – Any image, photographic, or otherwise, taken of tournament play or within the official venue is essentially the property of USA Table Tennis and CITTA regardless of the Approved status of the recording instrument or photographer. Entrants agree to allow their voice, video, pictures and likeness in such images/video to be reproduced in connection with USA**

**Table Tennis by way of any medium. USA Table Tennis is not responsible for, nor can they control, the use of camera phones inside the venue. Participants are hereby notified of this policy.**

**SafeSport Compliance: I understand USATT's Safe Sport Policy including the organization's Coaching Policy, which requires that all persons who are engaged in coaching activities at USATT Affiliated Member Clubs and/or USATT Sanctioned Tournaments, except parents or legal guardians coaching their own children, must be fully Safe Sport Compliant, which includes completing SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year and undergoing a criminal background screen every two years.**

#### **PERSONS IN POSITIONS OF AUTHORITY MUST BE FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT**

Under USATT Safe Sport Policy, persons holding certain **Positions of Authority** must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for Safe Sport (once per year) and undergo a criminal background screen (every two years). The list of Positions of Authority requiring **Full Safe Sport Compliance** is set out in USATT's Safe Sport Policy and the Athlete Safety Section of the USATT Website: <https://www.teamusa.org/usa-table-tennis/athlete-safety/safe-sport> .

#### **USATT COACHING POLICY**

All persons who are engaged in **coaching activities** at USATT Affiliated Member Clubs and/or USATT Sanctioned Tournaments, **except parents or legal guardians coaching their own children**, must be **Fully Safe Sport Compliant**, which requires completing SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year and undergoing a criminal background screen every two years.

#### **ADULT PARTICIPANTS REQUIRING SAFESPORT TRAINING**

Pursuant to USATT's Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, **ALL Adult Participants** (participants over the age of 18) **who have regular contact with or authority over minor aged athletes** must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year ("SafeSport Trained").

**CONTACT USATT TO BECOME SAFESPORT TRAINED AND/OR FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT** USATT is pleased to assist USATT Members in the process of becoming SafeSport Trained and/or Fully Safe Sport Compliant. **MANDATORY REPORTING**

There are certain circumstances where **reporting a potential Safe Sport violation is mandatory**. These circumstances include: (i) child abuse; (ii) sexual misconduct; (iii) emotional and physical misconduct; (iv) criminal charges and/or dispositions involving sexual misconduct or misconduct involving minors; (v) any abuse of the Safe Sport process. **Child abuse must be immediately reported to local law enforcement**.
