Singles Giant Round Robin Format	Players will be grouped into five divisions based on their current USATT rating, with up to 10 players in each division. Every match will be played as the best of five (5) games, with each game played to 11 points.			
Singles Ratings & OPEN Format	All matches will be played as the best of five (5) games, with each game played to 11 points, except for the Open Division Semifinals and Finals, which will be played as the best of seven (7) games. The tournament will begin with a round-robin group stage of up to four (4) players per group. The top two (2) finishers from each group will advance to the single-elimination bracket.			
Team Format	Each team consists of 2 or 3 players. For eligibility and rating purposes, a team's rating is calculated by adding the USATT ratings of its two highest-rated players. In each team match (tie), two players compete in the singles matches, while the optional third player may participate in the doubles match. The competition will use a round-robin format. Each team match is played in the following order: 1. Singles 2. Singles 3. Doubles 4. Reverse Singles (if necessary) 5. Reverse Singles (if necessary) The first team to win three (3) matches wins the team match, and any remaining matches are not played.

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USATT SAFE SPORT PROTOCOL ENTRY BLANK TEMPLATE FOR USATT SANCTIONED TOURNAMENTS

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I understand USATT's Safe Sport Policy including the organization's Coaching Policy, which requires that all persons who are engaged in coaching activities at USATT Affiliated Member Clubs and/or USATT Sanctioned Tournaments, except parents or legal guardians coaching their own children, must be fully Safe Sport Compliant, which includes completing SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year and undergoing a criminal background screen every two years.

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I understand that, pursuant to USATT's Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, all participants at USATT Sanctioned Tournaments who are over the age of 18 and have **regular contact with or authority over** minor athletes must complete annual SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport.
